


EASY HATS ON THE BOND

Take a gauge swatch first, then use the diagram measurements to figure out the number of sts and rows you need. Use a closed cast-on.



A baby's hat is 6.5" tall and 16" to 17" wide. These sizes are guidelines that you can adapt or use as is.

When you get to the top, thread a piece of yarn (the same as the hat is made of) through all the live sts. Sew up the side seam, then pull the yarn to gather the top. Add a pompom and Voila!

Use this pattern to experiment with different yarns and colors, and make a contribution to CAPS FOR KIDS at the same time.
